

Pennsylvania Christian Camp 2021 Covid-19 Mitigation Plan

June 18, 2021

Pennsylvania Christian Camp will operate this year with Covid-19 mitigation practices consistent with the current PA DOH guidelines at the time of camp. We will adjust these procedures as PA DOH guidance changes.

Currently this would include:

- Temperature and self-certification concerning Covid-19 on the day of registration at camp.
- Wearing masks indoors according to current Blue Knob State Park guidelines.
- Daily wellness checks.
- Isolation of any staff or camper with possible symptoms of Covid-19.
- Additional daily sanitation and cleaning procedures.
- Frequent hand washing and sanitation.
- Signage around camp promoting Covid-19 safety procedures.

If a camper or staff develops Covid-19 symptoms during camp:

- Camper or staff member will be immediately isolated.
 - Camper/staff member will be tested for Covid-19.
 - Parents of camper/staff member with symptoms will be notified of camper/staff member's condition.
 - Parents will arrange to have camper/staff member picked up within 12 hours of the start of isolation.
- All campers/staff members part of the symptomatic camper/staff member's cohort will be immediately isolated and monitored for Covid-19 symptoms until the person they were exposed to receives a negative test.
- If the symptomatic camper/staff member tests positive,
 - Camping session will close, and all campers will be sent home with notification of possible exposure to Covid-19.
 - The campsite will be sanitized.

If Pennsylvania Christian Camp receives notification of any staff or camper testing positive for Covid-19 after camp has closed:

- If the positive test is within 14 days of close of camp, all staff and campers will be notified of possible exposure to Covid-19 during camp.
